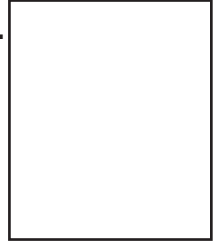

GENERAL INFORMATION

Nirmal Bethany High School and Jr. College is an Educational institution managed by the Bethany Congregation, a religious community, founded by Servant of God Archbishop Mar Ivanios OIC. The school was started by Malankara Catholic Association, Pune in the year 1987 and was handed over to Bethany Congregation in the year 1992. It is an unaided Christian Minority School recognized by the Government of Maharashtra. In the year 2013 the Jr. College of Science and Commerce also began to function.

‘ **Truth sets you Free** ’ is the motto of the school. Based on the rich heritage of India, we groom our students to be lovers of peace and non-violence and also promote universal brotherhood.

TRADITION TO BE KEPT:

1. Be always friendly to one another and respect all teachers & elders.
2. Avoid vulgarity in talk and behaviour.
3. Be helpful to others
4. Be courteous and supporting with officials and the competing teams of different houses.
5. Respect the liberty and rights of other pupils.
6. Handle with care all school properties.
7. Avoid dropping papers in the School premises, and pick up any such paper dropped by others.
8. Learn and observe good manners everywhere.

GENERAL RULES

Parents and guardians are requested to co-operate with the School authorities in the enforcement of these rules :-

1. All are expected to speak English in the School & Jr. College
2. Pupils should realize that they are responsible to the School authorities, not only for their conduct in the School & Jr. College but for their general behaviour outside also. Any reported or observed objectionable conduct out of the School & Jr. College on the part of the pupil makes them liable for disciplinary action (S. S. Code Sec. vii). On their way to or from the School & Jr. College the students must remember that the School & Jr. College is judged by their conduct.
3. Regular and punctual attendance is one of the conditions under which a child is admitted. Parents are earnestly requested not to ask for special leave.
4. To ensure regular in attendance and continuity in studies, leave will not be granted for any party or celebrations but in case of necessity. i.e. in case of illness the parents should inform the Principal in writing and on returning to School & Jr. College the students must bring a leave letter signed by their parents / guardians along with a medical certificate.

Violation of this rule will invite strict action from the part of the school management.

5. **All students should be present on the first day of School & Jr. College after any vacation such as Summer, Diwali and Christmas.** If the absence prolonged for more than a week without satisfactory document, the student is liable to be struck off from the rolls.
6. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence for more than a week, habitual idleness, disobedience, objectionable moral influence above all, **discourtesy and disrespect**

to Principal, teachers is a sufficient cause for dismissal from campus .

7. All the students are expected to be in the school & Jr. College before 7.50 a.m.. Late comers are liable to be sent home at parent's own responsibility.
8. No pupil who has been absent from School & Jr. College or late will be admitted to the class without the signature of parents or guardians.
9. At the first bell all the pupils should take their seats and keep silence. At second bell all should stand for prayer.
10. Any kind of damage done to the School & Jr. College property will have to be reimbursed.
11. Dress & Hair style should be suitable for School & Jr. College. Girl's should bob or platt their hair. Rings and fancy ear rings are not allowed.
12. Pupils are expected to come to School & Jr. College along with all the necessary books according to the time table. Borrowing pencils, rubbers, rulers, instrument box etc. is discouraged.
13. Pupils from one class may not visit their friends in any other class rooms during their recess.
14. When students move along the corridors for assembly and change of periods they must walk in silence keeping hands behind and single line and the rule is "keep left".
15. Silence must be observed outside the Principal's office, in the corridors etc. Running, or shouting in the School & Jr. College building is never allowed.
16. Attendance at school functions such as Children's Day, Teacher's Day, Sports Day, Independence Day, Republic Day etc. is compulsory. Absentees will be charged fine according to the decision of the Principal.
17. Parents are informed that their children are liable to be detained

by the Principal for any of the following reason

- a) Failing to wear the proper uniform.
- b) Failing to get the report card signed by the parent / guardian
- c) Failing the teachers remark in the diary signed by the parents / guardian.
- d) Failing to be on time for Assembly or class.
- e) Repeatedly forgetting to bring books.
- f) Failing to get the leave application records duly signed.

18. Parents should not meet the children or visit the teacher during the School hours without the sanction of the Principal.

19. No gift may be given to teachers. The parents by no means should visit teachers at their residence or phone them with regarding to School & Jr. College matters.

20. The management reserves the right regarding the admissions and retainments of students.

21. Studens are not expected to bring mobiles in the school premises. If it is found and caught, it will not be given back.

22. The students must look after to their own belongings. The school & Jr. College is not responsible for any articles which may be lost or stolen. No children are allowed to bring valuable goods, gold, fancy articles, wrist watches etc.

23. Light weight school bag & tiffin bag provided from School & Jr. College should be brought compulsorily to the School every day.

24. School Diary must be brought to School & Jr. College daily and should be maintained carefully. The parent should check the book daily and sign in the school diary whenever the information is given from the School & Jr. College.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Dirty or torn uniform should be avoided. Students will not be allowed to enter the School & Jr. College without proper uniform. Personal cleanliness and hygiene are greatly recommended. The uniform must be clean and neatly pressed, shoes well polished, finger nails pared and hair trimmed and neatly combed.

ON BIRTHDAYS THE STUDENTS FROM CLASS 1 - XII ARE EXPECTED TO COME IN SCHOOL UNIFORM ONLY.

UNIFORM FOR BOYS & GIRLS (I-IV)

Light blue shirt with dark blue strips & half sleeve, dark blue half pant with light blue strips, dark blue socks, black leather shoes and belt for the classes form I-IV . For girls light blue frock with dark blue strips for the classes from I-IV. Leggins are compulsory for girls from classes I-IV.

UNIFORM FOR BOYS & GIRLS (V-X)

The classes from V-X light blue shirt with dark blue strips & half sleeve, dark blue full pants with light blue strips, dark blue socks, black leather shoes and belt.

UNIFORM FOR JUNIOR COLLEGE

a) UNIFORM FOR BOYS

White Shirt with Blue Strips and full sleeve, Dark blue Pants, Tie, dark blue Socks and Leather shoes.

b) UNIFORM FOR GIRLS

White shirt with Blue Strips and $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve, Dark blue Pants, Tie, dark blue Socks and Leather shoes.

Dark blue pant, white shirt with blue strips and full sleeves, black shoes

SWEATER(COMMON)

On winter season, only Grey Knitted Sweaters are allowed for all from Nursery to Std. XII.

P. T. UNIFORM FOR SCHOOL & JR. COLLEGE(COMMON)

P.T Uniform is compulsory to all from class I-XII according to their House Colour. T-Shirt and Track Suit in Black Colour will be the permitted P.T unif

IDENTITY CARD

ID Card is compulsory from Nursery - XII. Fill up the Bio - data Form which is found in the School Diary, stick a passport size photo and get attested from School office.

NO STUDENT IS ALLOWED TO USE TWO WHEELERS & FOUR WHEELERS IN THE SCHOOL. ONLY BICYCLES ARE PERMITTED IN THE CAMPUS.

ADMISSIONS

1. Students are ordinarily admitted to Nursery. The admission process is being done only through online in the month of January.
2. Fresh admission has always to be sought for class- I for those who completed SR.KG in our school.
3. As per the Govt. regulations, currently in force, only pupils who have completed three years by July-I may be admitted to Nursery.
4. According to the government regulations, currently in force, only pupils who have completed six years by 1st June or the academic year may be admitted to Std.1st.
5. Original Birth Certificate along with a photocopy should be produced at the time of admission in Nursery.
6. Admission to the higher classes will not be granted to pupils from other schools until a Transfer Certificate from the former school is produced. Admission to the higher classes are given after they have been tested.

WITHDRAWALS:

1. **For the withdrawal of a student from the school, a letter signed by the parents / guardian should be submitted in the office before 30 days.**
2. Those who apply for L.C. after 1st of June should pay all the miscellaneous fees and the School fee of the 1st term or if it is after October up to May.
3. Students absent without notice more than 15 days will be struck off from the school rolls and shall not be re-admitted.
4. School fee is due as long as the name of the pupil is in the School rolls. They are requested to intimate the office when they leave the School.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTIONS

1. The School conducts two Semester examinations and four unit tests during the academic year. The reports will be issued in an open day which is held within three weeks after exam. It is compulsory that both parents / guardians should collect the report personally from the class teachers on the notified day itself. **The Cumulative performance in all these tests and examinations will be taken in to account for promotion and detention.**
2. The Periodic Progress Report as well as Semester Examination Report will be withheld for pending fee, or due to misbehaviour by the parents or students, unless permission has been obtained well in advance.
3. **The decision of the Principal, regarding promotion after the Annual Examination, will be final and not be re-considered.**
4. A pupil who use unfair means during examination / test will be given zero in the subject and debarred from the examination. Repetition of unfair means will make the pupil liable for dismissal from the School.
5. A student failing to appear for examination / test that will not be re-examined on any account. Results will be declared depending on the students performance during the year.
6. No students is allowed to take a study leave unless granted by the authorities.
7. For promotion a student must score at least 35% in all the subjects.
8. No student is allowed to repeat the same standard twice. If a pupil fails after repeating he / she will have to leave the School.
